### Contest Rules

In 250 words or less, write a love letter that would receive adamant approval and a knowing nod from Jane Austen.

#### Criteria:

1. Subject matter is LOVE. The letter can be directed to a loved one (sweetheart, family member, friend, etc.) or a cherished place or thing. Judging criteria will be based on creativity, heartfelt emotion, and true expression of love and appearance. The letter must be a contemporary original composition.
2. Winners will be chosen from each of the following categories:
  - Adult
  - College Student
  - High School Student
  - Junior High School Student
  - Middle School Student
3. Original letter must be handwritten and must be accompanied by a typewritten version. Additionally, a 12 point type Word document or PDF version must be sent electronically to [info@janeaustenfestival.org](mailto:info@janeaustenfestival.org). The words "Love Letter" and the entrant's name must appear in the subject line of the email transmission.
4. Deadline: Submission must be received by Thursday, March 13, 4:00 p.m.
